The exposed insulation is now covered with sheetrock. The walls are painted. The floor is now carpeted. The little girls room is now a princess room full of toys. The yard is raked & cleaned up.

The house passed DHS inspection and on October 6th, the 4 year old beautiful little girl is now backed to her loving mom & dad arms.
